

# ROBERTS 5601 Vinyl Seam Adhesive

**PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:**

Roberts 5601 Vinyl Seam Adhesive is a specifically formulated flammable solution for chemically seaming vinyl sheet flooring, Not recommended for vinyl sheet flooring with a urethane wear surface.

**SURFACE PREPARATION:**

Seams must be dry and free of adhesive.

Wipe the seam area with a clean cloth dampened with water. Allow area to dry before applying Roberts 5601 Vinyl Seam Adhesive.

**APPLICATION:**

To be used with an applicator bottle.

Do not shake Roberts 5601 Vinyl Seam Adhesive within half an hour before using to avoid air bubbles.

Transfer Roberts 5601 Vinyl Seam Adhesive to applicator bottle and reseal container tightly.

Starting at one end of the seam, insert the applicator tip into the seam and apply a continuous bead along the entire length of the seam. Avoid excessive downward pressure and maintain continuous pressure to the applicator bottle during the sealing process.

**CLEAN UP:**

To clean up equipment and adhesive spills, use Roberts 900 Cleaner/Thinner (Flammable) Roberts 900 is not recommended for removing adhesive from vinyl, carpet or painted surfaces.

**SHELF LIFE / STORAGE:**

Keep container tightly closed. Store Locked up.

Keep container in a cool well ventilated place away from sources of heat.
