

RLA Carpet Tile Pressure Sensitive Adhesive



DESCRIPTION:

RLA Carpet Tile Pressure Sensitive Adhesive is a solvent-free pressure-sensitive adhesive formulated for installing PVC-backed and modified composite-backed Carpet Tiles. RLA Carpet Tile Pressure Sensitive Adhesive can be applied to concrete substrates with moisture contents up to 85% relative humidity tested by In- the Situ Probe method and concrete substrates with pH readings of up to 10.0.

COVERAGE:

Coverage when applying the adhesive with a Long Nap Roller Pile height no less than 10mm can achieve an approximate spread rate of 8-10 square metres per litre.

- "V1" 1.6mm x 1.6mm notched trowel will achieve approximately 5 square metres per litre.
- "V2" 2.4mm x 2.4mm notched trowel will achieve up to 3 square metres per litre.

SURFACE PREPARATION:

To be by the current Australian Standard "Floor Coverings 1884-2021 Resilient Sheet & Tiles - Laying & Maintenance Practices." And Australian Standard 2455.2.2019 "Textile Floor Coverings – Installation Practice"

All surfaces should be dry, smooth, sound, clean and free of wax, grease, oil, previously applied adhesive, and other contaminants.

And laitance on concrete substrates should be removed before using this adhesive.

Subfloors must also be free of hydrostatic pressure and other impurities that may affect adhesion.

If mechanical preparation is required, prepare the floor using recommended methods such as shot blasting and diamond grinding to provide a roughened, clean, sound surface.

Thoroughly vacuum loose material and dust.

Test all concrete substrate flooring for moisture content according to the current Australian Standards before priming or installing any floorcoverings.

Curing time is related to temperature; this product should not be applied at temperatures below 10°C.

Priming or installing any floorcoverings.

Priming is only generally required when installing on overly porous subfloors,

If priming is required, use <u>RLA PU95</u>.or <u>RLA Universal</u> <u>Primer</u>

Indentations and uneven concrete subfloors should be treated with the Roberts and <u>RLA TruLevel</u> Product range of levelling compounds and by the manufacturer's recommendations.

APPLICATION:

Spread adhesive with the recommended notched trowel. Bonding Carpet Tiles to subfloor when laid in a releasable mode, we recommend using a long nap roller with a pile height of no less than 10mm.

Alternatively, a 1.6mm x 1.6mm "V1" notched trowel is recommended.

RLA Carpet Tile Pressure Sensitive Adhesive is used in dry mode, allowing the adhesive to dry, and become clear; this will limit the transfer of the adhesive to the back of the carpet tiles, therefore, enabling them to be relayed or repositioned with a clean backing.

A stronger bond can be achieved by laying the material into the adhesive film just before it dries completely; this will cause some transfer onto the back of the material. Complete installation according to the Floorcoverings manufacturer's instructions, ensuring the installation is rolled in both directions with the recommended roller weight.

CLEAN UP:

RLA Carpet Tile Pressure Sensitive Adhesive will tack up and turn clear after approximately 30 minutes to 1 hour at 20°C. Times may vary depending on substrate absorbency, temperature, and humidity.

CLEAN UP:

Clean tools immediately after use with warm soapy water. The dried adhesive may be cleaned off using a suitable solvent cleaner applied to a damp cloth, then rubbed gently over the dried adhesive.

SHELF LIFE / STORAGE:

12 months when stored in original unopened packaging To be stored in a dry area off the ground.

CONTAINER SIZES:

15-litre drum
