

ABS EDGE BAND CLEANER



DESCRIPTION:

TAC ADHESIVES – ABS EDGE BAND CLEANER is a low odour, multi-purpose cleaner formulated to clean off hot melt and solvent based adhesive from ABS edging without attacking the ABS edging. Also available in spray form, ABS Edgeband Cleaner is suitable as powerful degreaser for general cleaning applications.

USES:

- Cleaning ABS edging; including
 - Cleaning/removing contact adhesive
 - Cleaning off hot melt adhesive
 - Removing marker and pencil marks
- Cleaning and removing of adhesive from solvent sensitive surfaces
- Cleaning equipment and overspray of polystyrene safe grades of solvent adhesive
- Thinner for polystyrene safe adhesives
- General degreaser

APPLICATION:

Liquid Application

- Soak a clean rag with ABS Edgeband Cleaner
- Use the rag to clean off adhesives from the edging

Spray Application (aerosol)

- Spray Edgeband Cleaner on surface to be cleaned from a distance of 150 – 200 mm until surface is “wet”
- Wait 10-30 seconds then wipe surface with a clean rag
- Repeat if necessary

SHELF LIFE/STORAGE:

- Store under cover, out of direct sunlight and in a well ventilated area.
- Keep away from all sources of ignition
- Shelf life is 12 months when stored as per above recommendations

CONTAINER SIZE:

400ml aerosol spray, 20L and 200L drums
